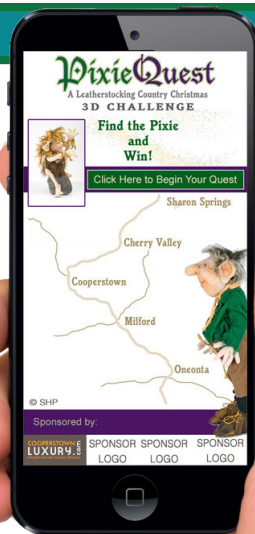

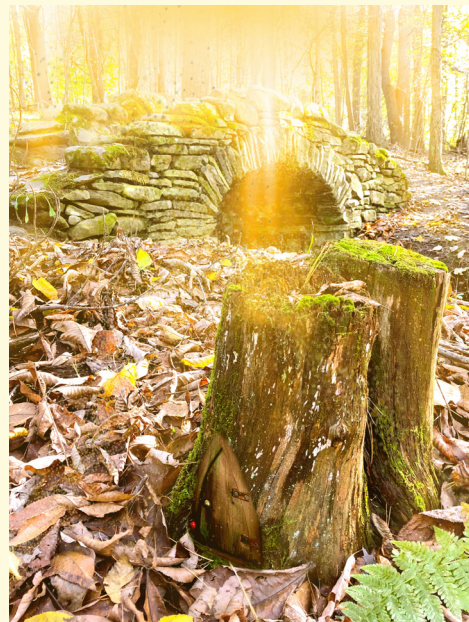

The Quest Begins

Aubrey opened the door of her home; a home built into the base of an ancient maple tree, and looked up through the thinning canopy of brightly colored leaves. The bright blue sky held a morning sun that was trying its best to push itself higher up into the sky so it could warm brisk autumn breezes. Aubrey smiled. 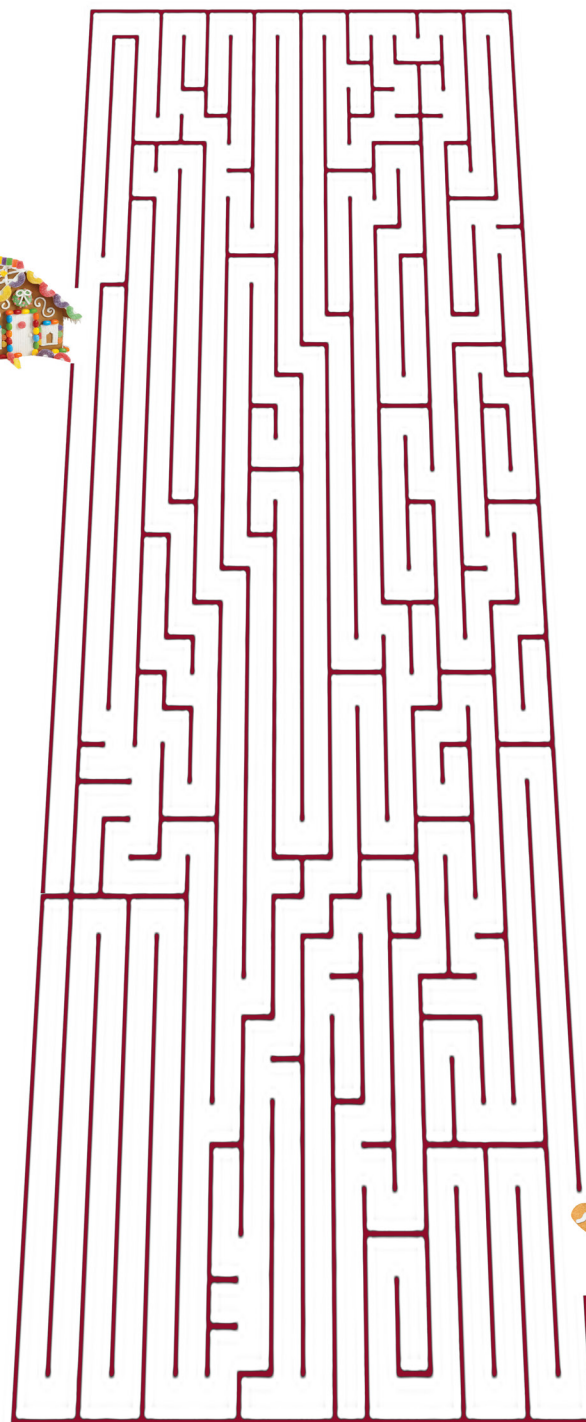
